

Local Board Meeting Minutes
Daguragu/Kalkarindji
30th July 2012

Present: Ben Window, Robert Roy, Leah Leaman, Penny Smith, Simeon Long, Robert Roy (Chairperson) and Michael Long

Meeting Commenced: 10:00am

Agenda: Freedom Day funding allocation and organization

Members discussed following up with Alan Holt and Naseem Chetty the amount of funding available for the festival.

Meatworks to be notified about killers for Freedom Day, all members present agreed to purchase 1 extra killer (approx. \$1000) from the meatworks for Freedom Day.

Ben moves a motion that Victoria Daly Shire release \$5000 from the Wankurr Sports Club as a donation towards Freedom Day Festival Costs.

Leah seconds the motion.

All present members agreed that a letter should be written to the Board of Directors for Karu Bulan Karni on behalf of the local board asking for a donation of up to \$2500 for groceries for the BBQ to be held on the Friday (24th)

Leah and Penny agreed to create a shopping list of groceries that will be needed for the BBQ on the Friday. Members agreed to budget \$2000 if Karu Bulan Karni are not willing to donate groceries.

All present members agreed to Penny organising dancers for the festival and budgeted \$1000 for them.

All present members agreed to holding a blue light disco on Friday night (24th) at the Daguragu Rec Hall. Robert Roy is to speak with the local police. It was also suggest that if possible the Shire's Sport and Recreation Officer help out at the event. All members agreed to spend \$250 on prizes for the disco.

All present members agreed to have the band play on Saturday night (25th). Budget allows for \$2000 for the band and \$2000 for hiring/purchasing stage equipment. Robert Roy to find out what equipment the school has that can be used and what equipment will need to be hired/purchased.

All present members agreed to purchasing new sporting equipment for the basketball, football and softball. Members also agreed to purchasing trophies for the winning teams and best and fairest for each sport. 2 new events will also be held, a 100m sprint and 800m race, members agreed to a voucher prize for the local store consistin of \$250 for 1st place in the 800m, \$100 for 2nd and \$50 for third and \$150 for 1st place in the 100m, \$75 for second and \$50 for third.

Members discussed faxing a flyer for the Freedom Day festival to other communities to ensure there are several teams to participate in sporting events.

All members agreed it is the responsibility of the Shire to organise a BBQ and firewood to be used on the Friday.

Robert Roy resigned as Chairperson at the end of the meeting
