Election of ward councillors – Victoria Daly Regional Council

Declaration of the election result

Election of 1 councillor – Daguragu ward

At the close of nominations on Thursday 5 August 2021 the number of candidates was not more than the number of vacancies and Georgina MACLEOD was declared elected.

Election of 1 councillor – Milngin ward

At the close of nominations on Thursday 5 August 2021 the number of candidates was not more than the number of vacancies and Andy MCTAGGART was declared elected.

Election of 1 councillor – Pine Creek ward

In accordance with Part 8.1, section 135 of the *Local Government Act 2019*, a periodic general election was held on Saturday 28 August 2021.

At the close of nominations there were 3 candidates, an election was duly held and the first preference votes recorded were as follows:

Candidate	First preferences
Alain DENOUEL	18
Lizzie SULLIVAN	16
Yvette WILLIAMS	76
Total	110

As a consequence, under the proportional representation voting system the quota of votes required for this election was **56**.

In accordance with Schedule 1 of the *Local Government (Electoral) Regulations 2021* the results are as follows:

- Yvette WILLIAMS received the majority of first preference votes

I therefore declare **Yvette WILLIAMS** duly elected as **Pine Creek ward** councillor under regulation 71 of the *Local Government (Electoral) Regulations*.

Election of 1 councillor – Timber Creek ward

In accordance with Part 8.1, section 135 of the *Local Government Act 2019*, a periodic general election was held on Saturday 28 August 2021.

At the close of nominations there were 2 candidates, an election was duly held and the first preference votes recorded were as follows:

Candidate	First preferences
Reg KING	40
Shirley Anne GARLETT	49
Total	89

As a consequence, under the proportional representation voting system the quota of votes required for this election was **45**.

In accordance with Schedule 1 of the *Local Government (Electoral) Regulations 2021* the results are as follows:

- Shirley Anne GARLETT received the majority of first preference votes

I therefore declare **Shirley Anne GARLETT** duly elected as **Timber Creek ward** councillor under regulation 71 of the *Local Government (Electoral) Regulations*.

Election of 1 councillor – Walangerri ward

At the close of nominations on Thursday 5 August 2021 the number of candidates was not more than the number of vacancies and Brian PEDWELL was declared elected.
